Facebook used to have women-only support groups. They're gone. They've been invaded by people with beards who use the group not for rape support, but to flirt, and to ask people to validate their femininity. Some are even more disturbing.

Chloe joined the women-only group. Chloe had obviously been through male puberty. The women would be discussing how rape left us feeling broken, suicidal, demolished. Chloe would respond with a flurry of selfies, usually wearing a cocktail dress and striking provocative poses. Chloe has a YouTube channel, featuring fantasies about kidnapping and torturing women.

Chloe's presence felt jarring and inappropriate. This was a person with a penis, showing up in what was supposed to be a safe space for women-only. Chloe pressed the women for validation, for compliments. The focus and tone of the group changed. Women gave up and left.

I raised the issue offline, with moderators. No response. Chloe popped up in the rape group again, once again posing in cocktail dresses. I asked something in the rape group about 'are you the Chloe who posts videos about kidnapping and torturing women?'

The result is that I was banned from the group, for making Chloe feel insafe.

Please. We need to be able to talk about these things. We need to be able to talk about transgender people's needs, wants, feelings, and lives. We also need to be able to talk about women's needs, wants, feelings, and lives.

Please don't silence women when we try to talk about males in women-only spaces. This isn't a matter of politics or lobbyists or identities. This is a matter of how women need to be able to name and discuss sex-based issues."
